

SUMMARY

1. The largest mean number of leaves appearing in a single week appeared in August after a period of heavy rainfall. The weekly rate of leaf appearance was most rapid between October 7 and November 4. Leaves appeared four out of five weeks during that time.
2. Seeds germinated both at 41^oF in darkness and at room temperature in sunlight.
3. Normal flowering occurred only with those plants which received seasonal cold treatment to December 11, and long days after introduction to the greenhouse.
